We (Al'Abbas and Isis) received this letter mid-way through Scarborough Faire 2012, and I asked Bob on Memorial Day if he really wouldn't mind if I shared it. He was so gracious and so positively supportive, that I'm passing this on to everyone. So many of you have verbally been appreciative of the opportunity to participate in a major festival and to grow in your skills, and I thank you for your so special comments. Thank you Bob Chabot, for "getting it" - the reason we are there, that we continue to work so hard to make this happen - and for your words that have touched my heart. With love, Isis

Dear Al'Abbas and Isis,

May I share? And if you are so inclined, please feel free to share this with others. It has been some time since I have felt this moved; no, make that compelled to write.

Drumming — as I suppose it also goes with dancing or any other activity, skill, etc. — has certain moments of self-realization wherein one accepts that improvement has occurred.

It is one thing to drum or dance alone. Or to do so in a class. They are the cobblestones that comprise our path. Most of the time, growth seems so slow in its pace and cadence ... a gradual tapestry stitched together from the threads of long hours of study; practice to link hands and drumskin to intent; encouragement and mirth from instructors and the drum mates one plays with; and more.

But it is by performing live — at events such as at Scarborough Renaissance Festival, haflas, graduations, even drum jams — that one truly sees how far one has come. Being able to perform live at Scarborough Renaissance Festival was such a moment for me.

I felt growth in an instant in so many ways ... no fear in performing; teamwork amongst drummers so that two, three, four or more drums sound more like one than not; the sweet harmony between the raw sound of drums and the graceful melody infused by the dancers; and then, to top it all, clear connection with spectators and passer-bys.

I did not anticipate how toes tapping, heads bobbing and bodies swaying would affect me. To see strangers — who know nothing of what we do or how hard we work — stop in the rush of their lives to linger for a moment ... caught by the rhythm and captured by the dance felt so sublime on the outside, yet so vividly tangible inside. It was like a "gift pro quo" ... what we gave to them was returned, but magnified. To see an eye twinkle, a child light up, a smile in the midst of a downpour or steamy afternoon, people jump onto the stage to try dancing, a lady in a wheelchair clapping in time ... those gifts trump anything I could ever offer them. In sooth, I had not anticipated that.

Let me reveal something of me: I am shy; incredibly so, although I hide it well. Please let that context frame what I now share with you. It was looking into the eyes of those strangers that I realized I had arrived, and that the journey to continue improving is worth every mistake that I will be make along the way. I could not have said this with conviction before, but I can say it now.

I am a drummer. My stage name will be Mecho (which Angie chose, as it is Bulgarian for "teddybear"). May the sound of my drum touch your soul, then echo back to my heart.

One more thing, if I may? Scarborough was the first time that I had both the chance and the confidence to play the drum while Angie danced — on the road as an Ambassador; off to the side during performances; and on the stage during the day-ending drum jam. I write for a living; words are the tools of my everyday work, yet they escape me in being able to describe how that felt when that happened. Which perhaps in its own way says it so much better.

ThankQ both for this first and very special opportunity, and for touching our lives. Your encouragement and mentoring makes wonders of, and for us all.
