



## A Dedication to Mom Mickie

March 19, 1919 - October 15, 2007



Edna Riddell Cobb McCall "Mickie"

This is so hard for me to write, but I really want you all to know how grateful
Del and I are for the opportunity to know so many wonderful and giving people.
Thank you dear friends for your touching cards, the flowers you sent and the love
you shared with hugs and memories. And, of course, I can never say enough
thank yous to those of you who stepped up and took over classes, organized
and set up the reception at the Studio and supported us at Mom's Farewell.

Mother would have been so honored to have heard all the wonderful memories you shared with us, and our entire families thank you for your kindness and support. We know so many of you have suffered losses and you truly do know the heartbreak of those losses. Again, thank you for your warmth and your caring.

I've been requested to share the short history that was read that day in memory of a very special woman who was also a very staunch supporter of the Dancers and Drummers of the Studio.

Sometimes it isn't until someone leaves this world that we discover who they really were/are. We'd like you to know about a beautiful, elegant and strong lady.

Edna Riddell Cobb McCall was the youngest of three children and a tomboy whose brother called her "Mickie". She climbed trees and played ball with the boys. In school she skipped a grade because, although she was the youngest in her class, she was so smart!

She married Robert F. McCall soon out of school and exactly a year later on their first anniversary, had their first of four children: Nancy, then Lana, Michael and Bobby. Their first three children were born during the war years and she joined the war effort working at Bell. She soon was in the vangard at Lockheed Aircraft Company, where she was in training and became a Technical Illustrator, drawing blueprints for their airplanes.

Raising her children while working, and in spite of frequently doing it alone, her children all graduated from school with both boys going into the Navy and both girls getting married as expected in the South of that era.

What wasn't expected was the need and ability to support herself and her children for many years. During this time, she also designed and made most of her work clothes and some for her daughters - sewing well into the night. She also made the wedding dresses for both girls. All the kids learned skills in order to help out at home.

During her times after her children were grown, she was fearless, driving over the mountains between Georgia and Tennessee to see her parents and help them many weekends as they grew older and had health problems.

Upon retiring from Lockheed after 30 years, Mickie moved to California near Lana, then to Arizona near Bobby and then to Texas near Mike and Nancy.

Mother believed in continuous education. She never took the time to enjoy fiction, but every book she read was a learning experience. In recent years she was fascinated by religion and psychology and started her journals searching for truths and understanding. She crocheted beautiful bed covers, handcrafted Christmas Tree skirts and stockings for all the family, appliqued special sweatshirts for her family and friends, and designed small special blankets for the great grandchildren.

Mother was never very social until she retired and started visiting Isis' Dance Studio. There she loved talking to the students and hearing about their lives and taking part in their special celebrations. She became a part of the Star Dancer family - coming to events, enjoying special people who were loving and kind to her, sewing hip scarves and adding coins and beads to costumes.

Thank you, Mother, for fighting the good fight - for passing on to your children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren so many of your talents; for your strength and determination through adversity, for being so proud of our accomplishments. We are so proud of YOU and so honored to be your children.
